
American History Teachers' Collaborative



AHTC Fellowship Opportunities Summer 2006

The American History Teachers' Collaborative Fellowship program is a unique opportunity for teachers to work on-site at one of the AHTC partner organizations. Fellows will divide their time between working as an intern for their assigned partner organization and preparing a unit plan based on the primary documents in the museum or archives.

- Fellows will work with one of the AHTC partner organizations: The Early American Museum, the Champaign County Historical Museum at the Cattle Bank, or the Champaign County Historical Archives.
- Fellowships will be two weeks long, 5 days/week for 4 hours/day. (Days of the week and times may vary depending on the partners' needs)
- Fellowships will be completed between June 12th and July 23rd.
- There is a mandatory orientation from 12:00-3:00 on Thursday, May 18th. Subs will be provided.
- Applications are due Thursday, April 13th.

Expectations for Fellows:

- Be active participants in AHTC activities
- Work for 40 hours at an AHTC partner organization
- Create a unit plan using the materials from the partner organizations
- Be willing to present the unit plan at an upcoming AHTC workshop or social studies conference
- Preference will be given to history teachers and those who regularly attend AHTC events

Upon completion of the expectations, fellows will receive:

- \$1080 Stipend
- Urbana teachers may choose to receive 5 hours of board credit in lieu of the stipend
