Lesson 6: Analyzing Photographs

- 1. Students should choose a recorder from each table. Hand out a copy of the Pleasant Valley School photograph to each table.
- 2. Give students enough time to look over the picture and discuss among themselves what they see in the photograph.
- 3. The student recorder writes down the group answers to the questions on the modified analysis worksheet for the photograph.
- 4. Project an overhead transparency of the <u>modified photo analysis</u> <u>worksheet</u>. Ask students to provide their answers to the worksheet.
