Direct examination, no interpreter used.

Hong Sling, applicant, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

- Q What is your boyhood name? A Hong Sling.
- Q Are you married? A Yes, sir.
- Cher Gul, Hong Lee, Hong Gat, Hong Ken, Q Have you a marriage name? A Hong Yuey Huey.
 - Q How old are you? AFifty-eight.
 - Q When did you first come to the United States? A KS 1st year.
- Q Are you registered? A Yes. I am registered, I don't know where my certificate is now. The manage of appending the there.
 - Q Where did you register? A In Chicago.
 - Q What kind of a certificate did you get? A Merchant's certificae.
 - Q What is your occupation? A Merchandise business.
- Q Give all your business? A Passenger Agent for Chicago & Northwestern Ry. and Union Pacific and Pacific Mail Steamship Company; I am also President of the Hong Fong Lo company which conducts a restaurant corner Van Buren and State street, Chicago.
- Q How long have you lived in Chicago? A Since 1892.
 - Q Have you been a merchant all that time? A Yes, sir.
- Q With what firm are you connected? A Sam Lung and Company, 431 So. Clark street, old number 299.
 - Q Who is the manager of that firm? A Myself.
 - Q How long have you been connected with that firm? A Since it opened.
- Q When was that? A I got that store, begin on Wabash Ave., and on State street for couple year.
- Q But what year did you start? A I forget exactly, what year, and start on Clark street about fourteen, fifteen year ago.
 - Q Did you organize the firm? A Yes, sir.
- Q How much is your interest in the firm? A I got twelve hundred dollar.

 - Q How many members in your firm? A Oh, I guess about twenty.
- Q What is the capitalization of your firm? A I think nineteen or twenty thousand dollars.
- Q What kind of business do you conduct? A Chinese grocery. Import tea, and greceries, got everything.
 - Q How many men work in the store? A Sometime eight or ten, sometime more.
- Q Can you name those who are employed in the store? A Yes. Myself, See Hoo She, Jin Ham, Hong Fat, Jin Chow Gui, Hong Lee, Hong Gat, Hong Nam, Hong Nguey, Hong Ley Ock, Hong Goon, Hong Jee, that is all I remember.
 - Q Who is the bookkeeper? A See Hoo She.
 - Q Does he look after the store when you are absent? A yes.
- Q How much time do you spend in the store? A I can't tell, sometime when I am not very busy outside, I spend all my time there.
 - Q Are you there every day? A Oh, sure.
 - Q Several hours a day? A Yes, sir.
 - Q Then your other business takes you outside too, does it? A yes, sir.
 - Q De you manage the Heng Fong Le? A No. I am President, we got manager there.
 - Q What is the name of the manager? A Les Fong.
- Q During the past year have you performed any labor outside the Sam Lung and Company? A No, sir.
- Q Have you ever been engaged in manual labor since you came to the United States? A Well first, two or three year.
 - Q Where was that? Oh, used to be west, in Wyoming.
- Q What are your property interests in the United States worth, what do you estimate your worth in the United States? A In the United States?
 - Q Yes? A Well, about thirty thousand.
 - Q Have you property interests in China too? A Yes, sir.
 - Q About what amount? A Well, about seventy or eighty thousand.
 - Q What is your wife's name? A Toy Shee.
- Q When and where did you marry her? A In China, KS 23rd year, when I went back to China that time.

- Q You were actually married in KS 23? A Yes.
- Q Is she your only wife? A Yes, sir.
- Q Did you bring her then to the United States? A Yes, sir, I bring her, coming into the United States, she was born in the United States, I brought her back with me after we were married?
 - Q How long after you were parried? A Four or five month.
- Q Can you give the steamer and the date on which you returned with your wife? A Steamer "Gaelic", I forget the date, about March or April, arrived San Francisco 1898, about that.
 - Q Did you land as a returning merchant? A Yes sir,
 - Q Of what firm? A Sam Lung Company.
- Q Did your wife enter as the wife of merchant? A My wife come on, she get certificate on Section Six.
 - Q Were you married according to the Chinese custom? A Yes, sir.
- Q There was no marriage ceremony, no liænse, no papers? A No, use Chinese way.
 - Q How many children have you? A Got three children of my own.
 - Q What is the name of the oldest? A Hong Wing You, American Harry Hong Sling.
 - Q How old is he? A Chines we call it sixteen year.
- Q Can you give the date of his birth? A MS 24, September 15, Chinee, 9th month fifteenth day.
 - Q Where was he born? A 324 So. Clark street on third floor.
- Q Did you live there with your family at that time? A Yes, sir, we lived there over ten year.
 - Q Who is the next child? A Hong Wing Gwong, American name William Hong Sling.
 - Q Is that a boy? A Yes.
 - Q How old is he? A Chines call it ten year.
- Q What is the date of his birth? A KS 30th year, and twelfth month and 26th day.
- Q Where was he born? A Just same place, 324 So. Clark street, third floor.
- Q Who is the third child? A Little girl, name Hong Wee Shan American name Jennie Hong Sling.

 - Q What is her birthday? A KS 32, lith month third day.
 - Q Have your children resided in Chicago ever since their birth? A Yes, sir.
 - Q Has your son Harry attended Chicago schools? A Yes, sir.
 - Q What school? A He went to public school, then he is in high school now.
 - Q What school did he first attend? A Jones school.
 - Q How long did he go there? A Since he was about six year old.
 - Q Did he start there in the kindergarten? A Yes, sir.
 - Q When did he quit there? A He graduated last June.
 - Q Then he want to what school? A Then went to Lane High School.
 - Q He is going there now, is he? A Yes, sir.
- Q What name does he use in the schools? A Harry Hong Sling; sometime call it Harry Hong.
 - Q De your other children attend school? A Yes, sir.
 - Q What school? A Jones school.
 - Q Going there now? A Yes, sir, every day.
- Q They both started in when they were five or six ? A yes, sir, always start in in Kindergarten.
 - Q Have you birth certificates for your children? A Yes.
- Q Have you got them here, Sling? A Yes, siv. (Shows birth certificates for Hong Wing Ye (Harry Hong), Hong Ring Quong (William Hong), and Jennie Hong).
- Q Do you remember the name of the doctor? That essisted at the birth of your son Harry? A I remember the name but I don't know where she is?
 - Q What is her name? A.Brigghouse?
 - Q Who sesisted at the birth of your son William? A Dr. Brennemann.
- Q And who assisted at the birth of your girl Jennie? A Same doctor, Dr. Brennemann.
- Q Have you any phtographs of your family? A Yes, sir. (Shows group photograph marked "Exhibit A").
 - Q Who is figure No. 1 of that picture? A Ey wife.

- Q Who is the boy standing by your wife? A Harry, my oldest son. (Figure No.2)
- Q Who is figure No. 3? A Hyself.
- Q And who is figure No. 4? A Second son, William Hong.
- Q And who is figure No. 5? A My little girl, Jennie Hong.
- Q There was this picture taken? A Taken here in Chicago.
- Q Do you know the photographer? A Gibson, used to be on Wabash Ave. over Jewne's grocery store.
 - Q What is this group picture "E"hbit B"? A That is my family picture.
 - Q Is the picture of your wife and three children? A Yes.
 - Q Who is the person standing, in the picture? A My nephew.
 - Q What is his name? A Hong Fong.
- ? There was this picture taken? A Kimball Hall, Chicago, on Wabash Ave.
- Q Who took it? A A cousin of mine and Mr. Root. My cousins name is Eddie Hong.
 - Q When was "Exhibit B" taken? A Couple month ago, two or three month ago.
- Q When was "Exhibit A" taken? A Few year ago, I forget now; taken about three or four years ago.
 - Q Have you any earlier picture than this? A Yes, it is in a frame.
- Q Can you name people in Chicago who know your children and know that they were born inChicago? A Lots of people know my children born in Chicago, and know my family: Mr. Mark Foots know my family and my children born in Chicago; and Mr. A. W. Ghapman; Mr. Henson; Mr. W. G. Niemyer, General Agent Southern Pacific; and Mr. Sam Hutchimen; Mr. Charley Wright; good many people know my children born in the City of Chicago. Frank Milchrist and Senator Milchrist.
- Q Who are your white witnesses to the fact that you are a merchant?A. Mr. Henson and Mr. Chapman.
 - Q Through what port will you visit China? A San Francisco.
 - Q What will be your address in China? A 104 Burham street, Hongkong. (Tracing of applicant's signature)
