## Historical Fiction Language Arts/Social Studies Unit Mary Reger

## Lesson 8

**Essential Questions:** What is historical fiction writing? How can I use artifacts and primary sources in writing historical fiction?

**Enduring Understanding:** Each student will write a historical fiction story including at least two primary sources in their story. They will use a graphic organizer (<u>Story Writing</u> <u>Plan</u>) to organize their ideas.

**Assessment:** Each student will complete a historical fiction story following the "<u>Historical Fiction Rubric</u>".

## Materials:

- Writing Notebooks
- "<u>Story Writing Plan</u>"
- "Historical Fiction Rubric"

## **Suggested Procedures:**

It is suggested this lesson be completed in one week.

- 1. Each student will choose a time period that their story will be in (American Revolution, Settler, Civil War, or Depression).
- 2. Each student will choose two or more artifacts and/or primary sources to include in their story.
- 3. Each student will fill out the "Story Writing Plan" before beginning to write.
- 4. Each student will write, proofread, revise, and rewrite a historical fiction story following the "<u>Historical Fiction Rubric</u>".
- 5. Each student will read their story to the class.
