

# LOOKING AT DISCIPLINE DATA

The process

# WHO LOOKS AT THE DATA AND WHEN

- Minimum of weekly to track data decision points
- Universal team looks at the big 5 monthly
- Monthly PBIS Staff meeting - all staff reviews the big 5 and other pertinent reports.
- Monthly Tier 2 Committee - look at referrals for individuals who have exceeded the data decision point.

# MONITORING THE DATA

Data decision point = 3 office discipline referrals in a month

- Secondary Intervention:
  - Check in Check Out (CICO)

# THE UNIVERSAL TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- Examining each component of the big 5 and making recommendations for improvement
  - Time of day - recommend brain breaks in the classroom
  - Location - playground/lunchroom recommended special incentive program
  - Behavior - included it as a goal for the month
  - Grade - review expectations
  - Student - ensure student has been referred for intervention

# PBIS STAFF MEETINGS

- Review data and recommendations from Universal Team
- Professional Development
  - PBIS Expectations - reteach and practice
  - De-escalation techniques
- Climate
  - Classrooms with high rates of office referrals require more staff checking in and giving incentives when students are caught being good.

# TIER 2 COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monthly meetings looking at the CICO data to ensuring students receiving these interventions are successful.
  - If not - recommend additional or different interventions
    - Social Academic Intervention Group (SAIG)
    - Gentleman's Club
    - Social Work
    - Community based counseling
