Academic Goal

CLIMATE GOAL

Using Restorative Practices, students will have the skills and resources to achieve behavioral expectations conducive to academic success. This is a shift from a punitive model to a restorative model.

OBJECTIVE

- Peer mediation: students holding themselves and others accountable through Restorative Practices
- Herff Jones group - Lower number of class disruption referrals
- Increase student attendance - Positively impact academic success
- All staff, students, and families will have a thorough understanding and implementation of Restorative Practices

- DRA data - Suspension/Expulsion data
- Attendance data
- In Good Standing

Family Engagement

Students and families will have greater access to and involvement with school and community initiatives that foster sustained and lifelong success.

OBJECTIVE

- Greater family involvement with parent-teacher conferences, access to academic and extracurricular events/programs
- Students and families will have a better understanding of academic and behavioral supports offered in school
- Develop effective strategies for coordinating communication between families, staff, and students

TYPES OF MEASURES

- Continue to track parent-teacher conferences among all demographic groups
- Teacher call logs
- Student/family surveys at Open House/Freshman Orientation
- Tracking of tickets/sales for extracurricular events
