Academic Goal: Reading



Goal: Students will be able to read appropriately complex text with understanding across multiple disciplines.

Objectives:

- ★ Students will demonstrate their ability to understand complex texts across multiple disciplines.
- ★ Families will understand and interpret their child's data and be able to support their child's reading progress at home.
- ★ Teachers and staff will collaborate in grade level data teams to analyze and interpret student data and make instructional decisions in response to student needs.

Academic Goal: Math



Goal: Students will gain a better understanding of number sense in the Base 10 system and improve their ability to persevere and problem solve.

Objectives:

- ★ Students will show progress in their understanding of number sense by their improved performance of number sense activities and assessments.
- ★ Families will gain an understanding of the importance of their child's knowledge of Base 10 thinking and how to support continued learning at home.
- ★ Teachers will regularly reinforce the Base 10 concepts as they move through the math curriculum.
- ★ Teachers will collaborate in grade level data teams to analyze and interpret student data and make instructional decisions in response to students' needs.

Behavioral Goal



Goal: Students will develop self-management skills that will help ensure academic progress and social/emotional growth.

Objectives:

- ★ Students will demonstrate socially acceptable problem-solving skills.
- ★ Students will follow school-wide PBIS expectations and earn RRS tickets as recognition & reinforcement of their positive behaviors.
- ★ Families will know and understand what self-management skills look like in the school setting.
- ★ Teachers will facilitate daily class meetings and utilize the district-provided curriculum, Second Step, to teach Social Emotional Learning.
- ★ Teachers will review Office Discipline Referral (ODR) percentage data on ethnicity.
- ★ Teachers will create a safe, respectful, and challenging learning environment for all students.

Partnership Climate Goal



Goal: Students will acquire the knowledge and skills to support and maintain a healthy lifestyle, which includes nutrition and appropriate physical activity.

Objectives:

- ★ Students will make healthier choices with nutrition.
- ★ Students will increase their physical activity.
