At the 2016 Illinois value of \$25.95 per volunteer hour (figure from "Independent Sector"), volunteers donated **\$157,892.78** dollars of time to #116 from September - December.

This year, several personnel changes have taken place with Mentoring & Community Involvement Coordinators in #116. Four new coordinators have been hired and one new position has been added (Volunteer Coordinator at Urbana Middle School and Urbana High School). In an effort to align with District equity goals, 75% of our new hires are people of color. Our current team will inherently provide multiple perspectives in coordinating community involvement endeavors.

The new Volunteer Coordinator position (at UMS and UHS) was added to address changes at the University of Illinois and in the larger community. This position will structure more intentionality around the recruitment of new volunteers.
