Meeting Purpose:

In groups, review each school's webpages and provide recommendations based on the following:- Things I Like, What I need, What I want, and Other thoughts/comments.

Things I like:

UMS: Homework blog- needs to be kept up to date; Announcements- when posted early in the day; Skyward; home page is inviting but perhaps update pictures to reflect current year; seems well organized, clear to find information about academics/activities.

Yankee Ridge: Principal message, History of the building, description of school colors and mascot

King: Picture of Principal and message from the Principal

Prairie: Homework Policy

Thomas Paine: Upcoming events on front page, Leal has pictures of students on their homepage, which is very welcoming; Leal has a history of the school, which made it feel established (a culture to attach to)

Wiley: Parent PTA link under parent link; online volunteer application; student organizations, picture of students on the front page

Leal: The pictures of the kids on the home page; more information provided in quick links; The history of the school makes people feel the school is well established.

What I need:

UHS:Create a hierarchical structure between the District and Buildings to increase communication and keep it updated very regularly, at least monthly, *each building could have more information pertinent to them.

UMS: Important Deadlines/Dates Coming Up- Better Calendar specific to UMS; contact list for specific problems; contact information for long-term subs; more clarity with homework blog with split LA classes; important deadline notifications,

Main office contact inform/general information numbers/email (not always sure who to go to for help with general questions)

Yankee Ridge:

Address and phone numbers more visible; health tips

King:

address and phone numbers more visible; more pictures (cube, rotate); newsletter on website

Prairie: Address and phone numbers more visible; more pictures (cube, rotate)

Thomas Paine: Link to Skyward on the front page with explanation and/or webinar; Focus on PTA- what it is, how to get involved, link to PTA website, meetings etc..; Focus on major events, news, changes

Wiley: Teacher bios; teacher website links; teacher newsletters; Skyward link up front (Quick link with explanation).

Leal: District newsletter on the homepage; link to parent advisory committee on the homepage; links to suggestions or questions on the homepage

What I want:

UHS: Need to get EVERYONE on skyward immediately. Suggest that Fall registration is not complete until families have logged into Skyward. We need to message (market) that we are great schools; Need to include more on Graduation rates – rotate focus on Academics/ Arts/Sports; List all clubs/Activities with links; Mission statement on top; automated tools to find broken links, need a way to contact "the site" with general questions and suggestions.

UMS: Easier way to get to team/teacher information

Yankee Ridge: Welcome message; Resource page (i.e. for homeless families, ESL); list of all TA's working with homeroom teachers

King: History about building/school; diversity numbers(ratio); information needs to be more concise on all web pages (too much information); Resource page (i.e homeless families, ESL); list of all TA's working with homeroom teachers

Prairie: Newsletter page needs updated, list of all TA's working with homeroom teachers.

Thomas Paine: Links to teacher individual websites; teacher bios on staff page; library information- more detail about reading levels/appropriate books; student organization information- how can I get my kid more involved?

Wiley: Focus on PTA- what it is/how to get involved; Reading Guidance for Accelerated readers; home page for every school should be "school information" and school news should be side link; access to sight words, common core.

Leal: The calendar link and important phone numbers on the homepage.

Other thoughts/comments:

UHS: Building and District Communication; No search bar which creates a problem when finding archived material; Guidance menu is too long and goes off page – Guidance is a broken link; Migration issue between District site and UHS Guidance site (Links are still "test"); problem for incoming families- District site for calendar does not work; staff not updated for 2013-2014; Better information on "how to use skyward"; Who updates these pages?; District Calendar for High School has no events- nothing. If I need to know when my daughter's band concert is there is no way. Directory- staff page not up to date

Thomas Paine: Current Quick links – not helpful especially front and center; Add quick links for: PTA, Skyward, District calendar); The featured article seems irrelevant, focus instead on major tools for parents; choose most important link from each category (information, programs, staff, parents, etc..) and put that as the quick links on the homepage; the school information should be the homepage; the school news should be a side category; Homepage should include district presence-like the newsletter.

Wiley: Battle of the books online; current quick links not entirely useful; quicklinks need to be centralized with the district; Include history of every school on Homesite,; Calendar- district calendar home page on all school homepages

Leal: The calendar look not very attractive.
