## **RESULTS FOR THE URBANA HIGH SCHOOL MATH TEAM AT THE ROSE-HULMAN COMPETITION**

Urbana – The Urbana High School (UHS) Math Team took three individual awards and one team award when they competed in the 48th Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology Mathematics Contest on Saturday, November 8, 2014. This annual event, held on the Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology's Terre Haute, Indiana campus, is one of the Midwest's largest academic contests.

Out of 470 students from thirty competing schools from several states, UHS's Anna Lubienski placed 9th in the Freshman competition. YeFan Shi placed 10th and Henry Ando placed 6th in the Junior competition. Overall, the UHS Juniors (Henry Ando, YeFan Shi, Haoxiang Li, and Hanyu Zhang) placed 3rd. All students took the same twenty-problem, one-hour test; however, they only competed against other students within their age group.

The contest consists of twenty multiple-choice questions. Five points are awarded for a correct answer and a one point penalty is deducted for an incorrect answer. Individual awards were given for the top twelve scores in each year. All participating students were eligible for these individual awards. There were three class awards for each of the four years, plus memorial awards for the top scoring male and female students in the freshman and sophomore divisions.
