

URBANA MIDDLE SCHOOL 2018-2019 Recommended Supply List

All Students, Grades 6-8

- The most important supply your student needs is a good <u>ZIPPER</u>
 <u>BINDER</u> (shown at right, 3-4 inches). Most classes choose not to
 use traditional textbooks, and the zipper binder is all your
 student will probably need to carry to and from school.
- Make sure you have the following, most of which should fit in your zipper binder.
 - o 7, two-pocked folders, three-hole punched (1 per class)
 - 1 package, 200 count <u>loose leaf, lined paper</u>, three-hole punched
 - o 1 package ¼ inch graph paper, three-hole punched
 - 1 bound <u>composition notebook</u> for science class (all grades)
 - o 2 bound composition notebooks for Language Arts and Social Studies (sixth grade only)
 - o #2 pencils (mechanical preferred); if not mechanical, pick up a personal pencil sharpener
 - o Pens (blue or black)
 - o Extra erasers (you will need even more if in Art)
 - o <u>Highlighters</u> (at least two colors)
 - o 1 basic scientific calculator (such as Casio fx-300MS)
- Additional supplies you may keep in your lockers and access when needed
 - o 1 box colored pencils (add a second set if in Art)
 - 1 box <u>washable markers</u> (add a second set if in Art or 6th grade)
 - o 1 box <u>crayons</u> (6th grade only)
 - o 4 boxes of facial tissue (these are collected and shared among all students in the class)
 - o Glue sticks (add additional if in Art)
- <u>Physical Education Clothes</u> (students do not need to bring PE clothes on the first day of school)
 - Athletic shorts (blue or black)
 - Plain t-shirt (grey or white)
 - Athletic shoes
 - Swimsuit (about 80% of students will have a unit of swimming)
