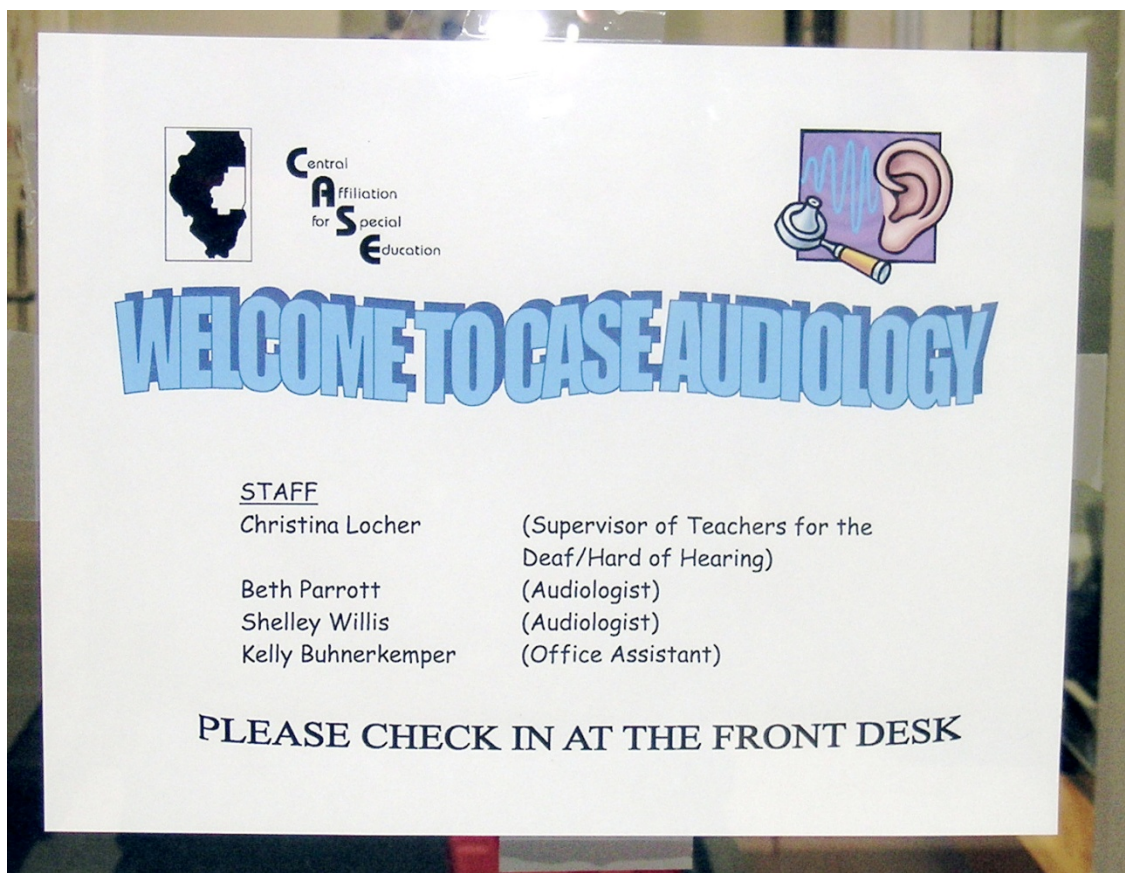


My hearing test

This is an Otoscope.
The audiologist will use it to look
into my ear. It will not hurt me
