- The most important supply your student needs is a good ZIPPER BINDER (shown at right, 3-4 inches). Additionally, a STRING BAG (shown at right) is recommended. Most classes choose not to use traditional textbooks, and the binder is all your student will probably need to carry to and from school. String bags are not required.
- Make sure you have the following, most of which should fit in your zipper binder or string bag.
- 7, two-pocket folders, three-hole punched (1 per class)
- 1 package, 200 count loose leaf, lined paper, three-hole punched**

- 1 package $1 / 4$ inch graph paper, three-hole punched
- 1 bound composition notebook for science class (all grades)
- 2 bound composition notebooks for ELA class (all grades)
- 1 bound composition notebook for Social Studies ( $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ grade and 8 th Spanish SS only)
- 1 subject spiral notebook to be left in the classroom for 6th grade Social Studies.
- 1 bound composition notebook for Spanish Science
- 1 1" binder for Spanish Language Arts
- 2+ packages of \#2 pencils (mechanical preferred); if not mechanical, pick up a personal pencil sharpener**
- Pens (blue or black)**
- Extra erasers (you will need even more if in Art)**
- Highlighters (at least two colors)
- 1 basic scientific calculator (such as Casio fx-300MS)
- Additional supplies you may keep in your lockers and access when needed
- 1 box colored pencils (add a second set if in Art)
- 1 box washable markers (add a second set if in Art or 6th grade)
- Glue sticks (add additional if in Art, ESL, or Dual Language Program)**
- Pair of scissors (ESL only)
- 1 box crayons (OPTIONAL -- $6^{\text {th }}$ grade only)
- 4 boxes of facial tissue (these are collected and shared among both team and elective teachers)**
- 1 pack of anti-bacterial wipes (these are collected and shared among both team and elective teachers)**
- Headphones (OPTIONAL but highly encouraged -- for use in conjunction with school approved technology)
- Physical Education Clothes: It is required that students have athletic clothing and shoes to change into for P.E.; students will change in the locker rooms and will keep their items in an assigned PE locker with a lock.
- Athletic clothing may include: shorts, t-shirts, sweat pants, leggings, socks, gym shoes, etc.
- Students must still follow all dress code regulations while dressing for PE
- Swimming is TBD, but if approved, a Swimsuit would be required(about $80 \%$ of students will have a unit of swimming)
